 - SAB Application is now available! Please consider sharing your skills and talents with us by serving on the SAB for the 2021-2022 school year. The role of the board is to provide counsel and advice to the pastor and principal regarding: Mission Effectiveness, Member Development, Financial and Physical Resources, Institutional Advancement including: Communication, Marketing, Recruitment/Enrollment/Retention, Development and Creation of the school's long-range strategic plan. The minimum time commitment is about 2-3 hours per month including a monthly meeting and follow-up committee work. 

- April 30th is the Cutoff for this year's Manna Requirement. Reports were sent home in folders the week before Spring Break summarizing total rebates earned. You can also pull reports anytime from shopwithscrip to see accrual rebates from purchases made online (Select June 1st Present). See page 4 of this link for detailed "how to" reports. Around May 15th, you will see a fundraising fee in FACTS if you have not reached the \$300 school earnings requirement (\$300 minus what you've earned for the school thru the program). Remember, the \$175 fundraising fee that was normally charged at the start of the year was eliminated to give families an opportunity to reduce the fee as much as they can. The deadline to accrue towards the \$300 requirement is April 30th. Thank you all for your participation! It's making a difference.


