Through monetary donations and the t-shirt and lawn sign fundraiser, as a community we raised over \$3,500 to donate to the Little Company of Mary Cancer Center in honor of our 2 beloved faculty members who are currently fighting this disease. Thank you to the parent volunteers who came out today and those that lined the streets to cheer us on! Also, a huge shout-out to the Chicago Police Department for their energetic presence ensuring our safety along the way. Days like today remind us just how incredible our community is. We are always there for one another and never stop showing up. For this reason and countless more, thank you.

There is a rigorous application process where students have to discuss ways in which they are making a positive impact on the world and truly embodying Conner's motto: "Live life kind. Each of these impressive Falcons will receive a financial award to help pay their tuition for the 2021-2022 school year. The CTL scholarship winners also play an instrumental role in leading our student body during their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year. We are so grateful that Jimmy, Grace, Danny, Gillian and Maura are Falcons; they have set a beautiful example for all of us. Congratulations to these Falcons and their families! We honor Conner this Memorial Day Weekend and all of the men and women who have died for our freedom.


