1. PLEASE SUBMIT: Manna Waiver Form - Agreement for gift cards to be sent home through school. Submitting this form will signal to the Manna team that you'd like ALL ORDERS to be sent home from school.

2. Use www.shopwithscrip.com or Raise Right App.

Place order by **10 AM on Sundays** and gift cards will be sent home on **THURSDAYS.** If you miss that deadline, your order will be sent home the following Thursday.
Note: if this is the method you choose, all orders submitted and paid for will be delivered

this way. If you decide to revert back to picking up your orders at the convent, please email sjfmanna@gmail.com to be removed from the "Send Home" list. 
FALCON OF THE WEEK


