

Dear Parents,

St. John Fisher will be sponsoring a fall soccer league for children of the parish entering kindergarten through fifth grade\* (if we get enough 4th& 5th graders to field a team). All games are played on Saturdays in Beverly Park during the months of September and October.

If your child would like to participate in the league, please print the form, fill out the application, and return it to the school with a check for \$25 payable to St. John Fisher Soccer. The deadline is June 6th. You may write one check if you have multiple children participating, but a separate application must be filled out for each child. Please place the check and all applications in an envelope marked SJF Fall Soccer 2022. Checks and applications may be sent in to the school office up until June 6th.

We cannot guarantee requests to group children together unless they are from the same family, but if you have a specific request please write it on your application.

The soccer program would not survive without parent volunteers. Most of the jobs require very little time and are extremely rewarding. Prior experience is not necessary; this is to be a learning experience for kids and the parent volunteers. Please think about volunteering to be a coach (we try to assign two coaches per team - so you will have a partner) or referee. Remember that the season is only eight weeks long, with a break over Columbus Day weekend.
