The mantle was then draped lovingly over the members of the household, who knelt before an image of Our Lady, offering their lives to her... On day two, the mantle traveled to the next household, where it received a second star, until the last home was visited on the 46th day, December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe." – Mary's Mantle Consecration by Christine Watkins
