Important Announcements

- Lockdown Drill: Our Falcons did an excellent job practicing our lock down drill. It sickens me that we live in a world where these drills are a necessary critical part of our lives. We love our Falcons and their safety is our number one priority. Our CPD School Sergeant as well as 4 other CPD Officers were present for our drill to provide feedback. They were overly pleased with our process and gave us confidence that we are prepared. We will continue to practice these drills both announced and unannounced throughout the school year.
- <u>Uniform Update</u>: Students are expected to transition to the traditional uniform on October 1st.
 - Girls:
 - K-2: Plaid jumper and blouse/polo (white, navy or light blue)
 - 3rd: Plaid jumper OR plaid skirt and blouse/polo (white, navy or light blue)
 - 4th-8th: Plaid skirt and blouse/polo (white, navy or light blue)
 - K-8: Solid white, navy or hunter green sweater or SJF gray fleece, navy quarter zip or crewneck with SJF logo
 - K-8: Navy or khaki pants may be worn 10.1 5.1
 - Sweats and Pajama bottoms CANNOT be worn under skirts. Girls can wear leggings or tights (black, navy, hunter green or gray)
 - Boys:
 - K-8: Navy or khaki pants and white, navy or light blue polo shirt
 - SJF gray fleece, navy quarter zip or crewneck

- Extended Day: <u>Don't forget to sign up your Falcon(s) here</u>. If you have questions, please reach out to Mrs. O'Grady, dogrady@sjfschool.us
- Sick Policy: Parents are required to keep children home from school the following day if they have been sent home with vomiting, fever (100 degrees), rash or diarrhea. Students must be fever free without the use of fever reducing medicine for 24 hours before returning to school. 


St. John Fisher Proudly Hosts Future Falcons Playgroup

Why Play?


At SJF, we value intellectual, academic, social & emotional growth. Through play, children are able to develop these skills while building relationships within their community.


